The Waterford Graded School District is forming an advisory committee to develop a recommendation for the Board of Education regarding elementary school boundaries for the 2019-2020 school year and beyond. This work is in preparation for the District's middle school facility project being completed at the beginning of the next school year. A representative group of elementary school parents, preschool parents, teachers, and district administrators will meet from October to January to develop a possible recommendation(s) for consideration by the Board of Education.

The focus of the committee will be to address the past and projected residential growth within the Waterford Graded School District boundaries and the need to maximize the equity and service of our elementary schools.

Desired outcomes of the process include:

- Develop criteria for proposals Investigate current and projected enrollment
- Investigate population growth and residential development
- Review other data/information relevant to the committee's recommendation(s)
- Develop an elementary school boundary recommendation(s) for the school board's consideration
