Rationale - The rationale for a staggered start to the 2020-21 school year: Due to our efforts to ensure student safety, new routines and pathways for appropriate physical distancing beginning the school year with a staggered start allows more teachers to support students and ensure their safety.

Rationale

The rationale for this option is it allows for a safer return to school by reducing the number of students in the building at one time. Physical distancing is more approachable and enhanced PPE will not need to be used as much as in the In-Person option. Virtual Wednesday's allows for students to cultivate online skills in the event we go fully virtual. Creating subgroups within the A/B rotations would allow a more equitable approach to teaching and learning.
